Tashlich or “casting away” is a traditional ceremony held on the first day of Rosh Hashanah during which individuals symbolically “cast away” their wrongdoings from the previous year by tossing breadcrumbs or stones into flowing water.

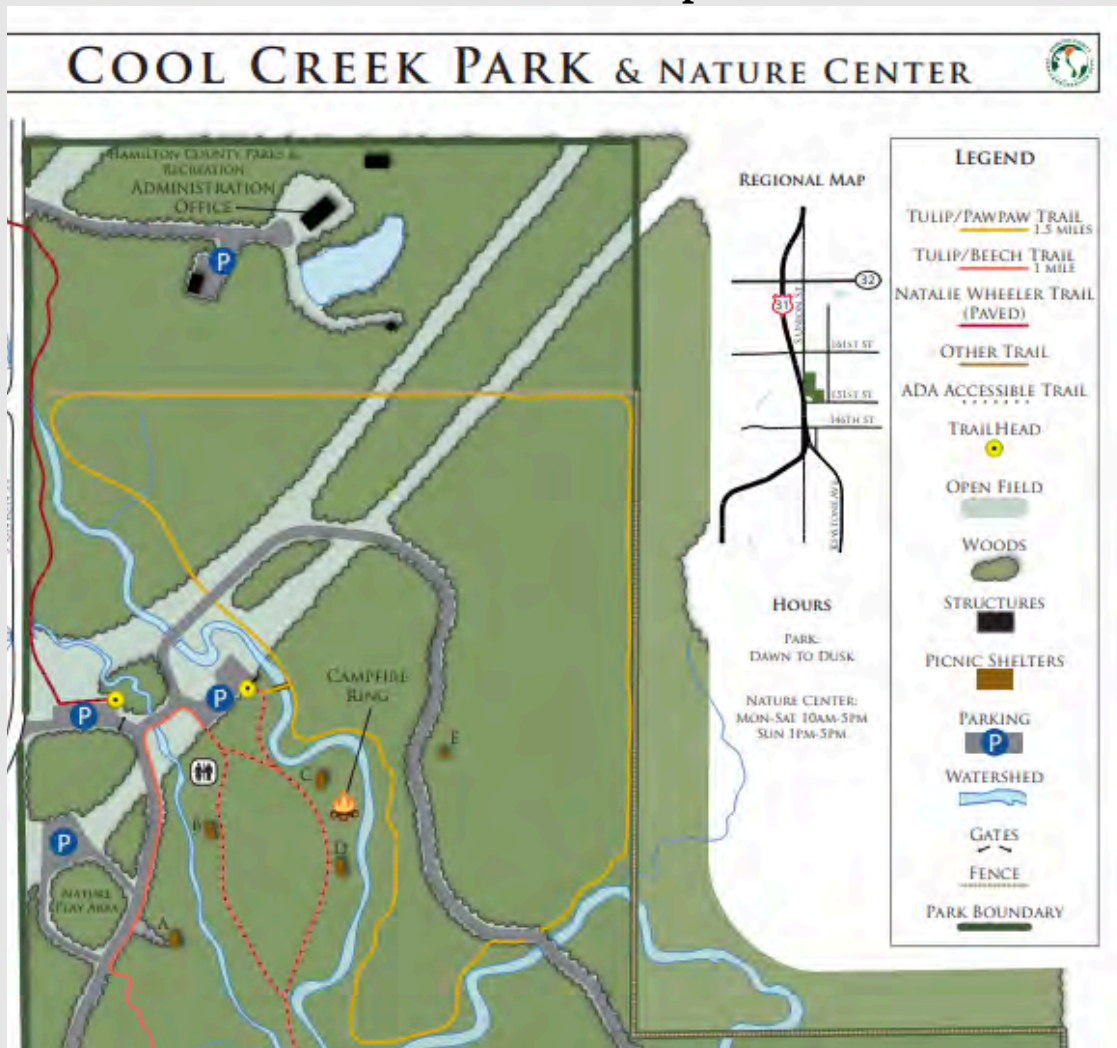
Tashlich will be held at Cool Creek Park in Carmel.
